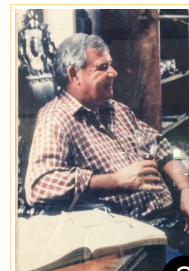
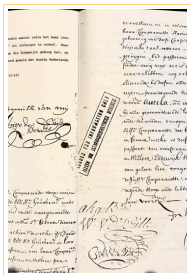
We honour our history and bring it to life through our wines and estate culture. Every wine in the Muratie range is named after someone who played a pivotal role in our story, which dates back more than three centuries to 1685. While we cherish our past, we look forward, building on a legacy through a commitment to excellence in both wine and visitor experiences.

Muratie's journey began in 1685 when the land was granted by Simon van der Stel, Governor of the Cape of Good Hope, to German soldier Laurens Campher. Over the centuries, this historic estate, one of South Africa's oldest, passed through the hands of other notable owners and is now under the stewardship of the Melck family, who share deep roots here.

Every chapter in Muratie's story is captivating, and our mission is to preserve this rich heritage and share it with wine lovers worldwide. At the same time, we're dedicated to creating a future legacy of excellence. At Muratie, we're all invested in writing the next great chapter.

EVERY WINE TELLS A STORY – SINCE 1685

With a history stretching back more than three centuries, numerous people have played an important role in its development and success of today's winery. Those great personalities are honoured in today's wines as a tribute to the heart and soul they put into Muratie's enduring reputation.



1685 THE STORY BEGINS

Laurens Campher, a young German soldier, started cultivating the agricultural land in 1685. Today, the white flagship cuvée bears the name of the young pioneer and founder. From day one on the Cape, Laurens' heart belonged to slave Ansela van de Caab. To visit her, Laurens regularly braved the three-day march between Stellenbosch and Cape Town. With the attainment of her freedom in 1695, Ansela was able to move to the farm with their three children. A Bordeaux-style red wine cuvée proudly bears her name.

1763 MELCK ERA

After Ansela and Laurens sold the farm in 1735, the estate was in the hands of six owners. In 1763 it was finally acquired by Martin Melck, who, like Laurens, had come to South Africa as a soldier. After his death, his daughter Anna Catherine, her husband and children ran the farm for 120 years and it remained in family ownership. Martin Melck is the godfather of Muratie's pure Cabernet Sauvignons.

1826 CANITZ FAMILY ART MEETS WINE

Born in Leipzig, Germany, Georg Paul Canitz dedicated his life to art. Inspired by Renaissance masterpieces, he spent endless hours in his art studio on Muratie. He achieved special fame with Amber Forever, a dessert wine, in reference to his muse, a beautiful woman who was often the subject of his romantic paintings.

1957 BAREFOOT BEN

Ben Prins, the winemaker at Muratie until 1987, was as unique as the wines he produced. His great love for South African soil led Ben to hike the steep slopes of the Simonsberg mostly barefoot – thus inspiring his nickname "Barefoot Ben". In his honour, our vintage port (known as Cape Vintage in South Africa) made from traditional Portuguese varieties, is named Ben Prins.

1958 A FEMALE LEGACY

After the death of Georg Paul Canitz, his daughter Alberta Annemarie took over the winery in 1958. As one of the first women in South Africa to own a wine farm, she was actively involved in the winemaking and sales. Her great passions were equestrianism and the conservation of Muratie's history. The powerful Merlot bears her name in memory of this strong woman.

1987 A LIFE'S DREAM FULFILLED

The Melcks return to Muratie: Ronnie (Ronald) Melck fulfilled his lifelong dream by buying the farm from Alberta Annemarie and the winery came back into family ownership. Unfortunately, he could only savour life on Muratie for a few years before he passed away. Ronnie Melck's convivial spirit lives on today in the family's legendary Syrah Selection.

2005 THE STORY CONTINUES

Rijk and Kim Melck are passionately continuing the more than 300-year history of the winery today. They have entrenched the value of family and relationships as part of the Muratie culture, and aim to carry this heritage over to the next generation.
